Introduction:

Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological University, with its headquarters situated at Lonere, Raigad is now a statutory State Technical University established by Government of Maharashtra through special Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological University Act. The University has been accorded the status of an 'Affiliating' University of the entire State of Maharashtra from March 2, 2016, by the Maharashtra Act No. XXIX of 2014.

University is empowered to affiliate institutions that offer Degree, Post-Graduate and Ph.D. level programmes in the disciplines of Engineering, Pharmacy, Architecture and Hotel Management and Catering Technology. Tertiary of the University is entire Maharashtra. Presently 240 institutes are affiliated to the University. University is going to establish four regional centers and five subcenters in different regions of Maharashtra.

Students can also opt for some interdisciplinary courses as per their choice. Students can take benefit of Academic Bank of Credits(ABC) facility. These courses will be available for ODL(Open Distance learning). CBCS will be implemented for these programs.

University is planning to provide 6 month certificate and training programs for graduated students to bridge the gap between HEIs and Society and Industry in following areas:

Cryptocurrency and Blockchain Technology, Medical Instrument Training, Supply chain management of agricultural commodities and enriching value chains and Agricultural Marketing Management, Digital Literacy, Basics of Legal and HR Policies, Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Security Infrastructure Specialist, Cyber Crime and Digital Forensics.

B. Flexibility of Courses and Student Mobility-Multiple Entry and Exit

- Signing MoUs to provide credit based courses for students and transfer of credits from such courses.
- Deriving a very dynamic system for multiple Entry and Exit for Integrated and Trans disciplinary and well as traditional courses and programs
- Multiple Entry and Exit policy will be implemented from AY 2022-23 for all programmes. Presently the credit transfer facility is in place for the courses offered by SWAYAM and NPTEL.

Further, the University will be translating all remaining books of UG and Diploma Engineering programs in coming three years to promote the regional languages.

The University is planning to start Community Radio Station (CRS) in the premises of main campus for creating awareness among the society about IKS. Also, this will be used for spreading awareness about various Government schemes and opportunities.

- Setting Entrepreneurship Development Cell in University which will provide guidance and financial aid to Entrepreneurs for their Start-up Ideas.
- Helping students, research scholar and faculty for publishing patents which are useful for transfer of technology to society
- Increase interaction with other academic institutions & industries of high repute for carrying out joint research and innovation.
- Institute will enhance the research environment by initiating Post – Doc Fellowship Programs.
- Emphasis on research based on Industry 5.0
- Establishment of Research Park and Skill Hub

E. Ranking

University aims to achieve higher ranking in NAAC, NBA, NIRF, QS World University Ranking.

Presently the University has initiated following activities:

1. Development of state-of-the-art Remote Sensing Laboratory, 3-D Printing Laboratory.
2. Formed the Section-8 company to promote Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship activities. Presently provided funding to four start-ups, further, in

coming 2-3 years University will identify about 50 start-ups and will support these start-ups to create job opportunities in near future.

University introduced mandatory six month internship program for final year students in partnership with the leading industries.


Summary

All Deans, Head of Departments, Office-bearers, Teaching and Non-teaching staff members of various branches, students were present for the Independence Day function.

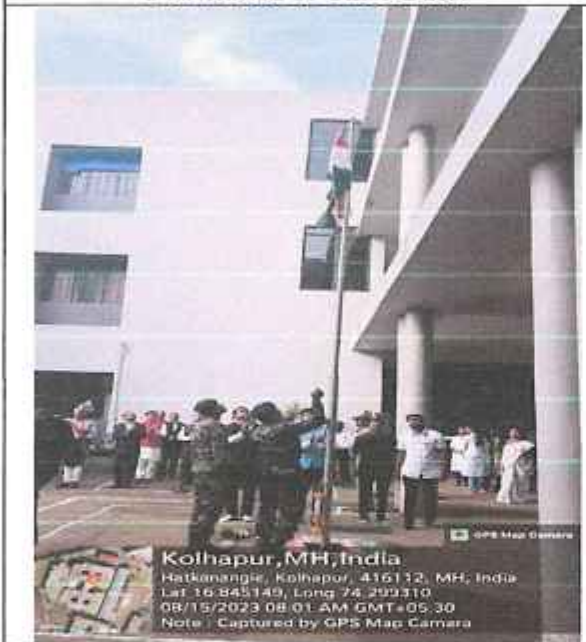

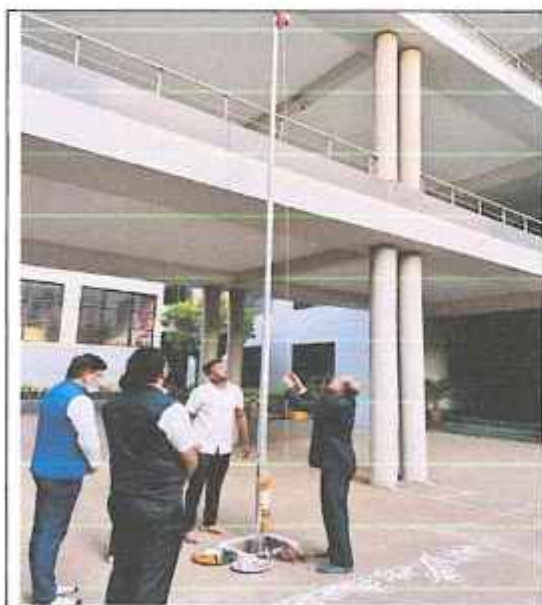
