

Introduction:


77th Independence Day on 15th Aug. 2023.

Cultural Performances (GARBA DANCE COMPETETION)


The program included vibrant cultural performances, such as:






Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Jayanti (14th April 2024)

Republic Day (26th Jan. 2024)






Objectives: - To promote awareness and understanding of the spiritual and cultural importance among the students.
